

COUNTY OF OXFORD

BY-LAW NO. 4668-2006

BEING a By-law to repeal By-law No. 4628-2005 and to adopt a new schedule of fees for the disposing of waste at the County Landfill Site at Salford.

WHEREAS, section 12 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001 chapt. 25, provides that Oxford County has exclusive jurisdiction over the entire sphere of waste management, with the exception of shared jurisdiction over waste collection.

AND WHEREAS, it is desirable and expedient to establish a long-term schedule of fees for the disposal at the Site of solid waste.

AND WHEREAS, Council has adopted Public Works Report D-2 2006-30, dated March 29, 2006,.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of The Corporation of the County of Oxford enacts as follows:

1. For disposing of waste the fee will be the following amount per tonne effective on the following dates:

Current	\$40.00
July 1, 2006	\$45.00
January 1, 2007	\$50.00
July 1, 2007	\$55.00
January 1, 2008	\$60.00
January 1, 2009 and annually thereafter	Percentage increase based on the Consumer Price Index

2. For disposing of items containing Freon, the fee will be \$15.00 per item plus tipping fees, if the item (or items) is (or are) part of a load with other waste. No tipping fees apply if the load contains no other waste.
3. For disposing of passenger vehicle and light truck tires (without rims) to a maximum of 18" and a maximum of 8 tires at any one time, the fee will be \$2.00 per tire plus tipping fees, if the tire (or tires) is (or are) part of a load with other waste. No tipping fees apply if the load contains no other waste.
4. Commercial truck tires and tires from agricultural equipment will not be accepted at the Site.
5. By-law No. 4628-2005 is hereby repealed.

READ a first and second time this 12th day of April, 2006.

READ a third time and finally passed in Open Council this 12th day of April, 2006.
