## BY-LAW NUMBER 8499-08

A By-law to amend Zoning By-law Number 5899-81, as amended.

WHEREAS Section 39 of the <u>Planning Act</u>, as amended, authorizes Municipal Councils to pass bylaws to permit temporary land uses for specific periods of time;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Woodstock deems it advisable to amend By-law Number 5899-81, as amended, to permit the placement of a mobile home on certain lands in the City of Woodstock as a principal dwelling on a temporary use basis;

THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Woodstock, enacts as follows:

- 1. A 'Mobile Home' as defined by City of Woodstock Zoning By-law No. 5899-81, shall be permitted on those lands identified as the Subject Lands on Schedule "A" (attached to and forming part of this By-law).
- 2. A mobile home as identified in Clause 1 of this By-law shall be permitted in accordance with the zone provisions of the 'Limited Agricultural Zone (A1)' as contained in Township of Blandford-Blenheim Zoning By-law No. 1360-2002.
- 3. A mobile home as identified in Clause 1 of this By-law may be permitted on the subject lands for a temporary period commencing on November 6, 2008 and ending on November 6, 2011, at which time the mobile home must be removed from the subject lands.


This By-law comes into force in accordance with Sections 34(21) and (30) and Section 39 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended.

READ a first and second time this 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2008.


READ a third time and finally passed this 6<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2008.




