Adoption of Agenda	Agenda – Acce	pted as presented.	

Oxford	Ayesha informed the Committee that the Staff Lead from Ingersoll's AAC	City of London's
County's	couldn't come to this meeting. However, Ingersoll's Accessibility toolkit	FAD
Accessibility	was discussed during the Joint Accessibility meeting (2023), and they	
Assessment	utilized the OBIAA Accessible Building Checklist to assess their facilities

Checklist	The purpose of updating Oxford County's Accessibility Checklist	
Review	Assessment Form was discussed in detail, i.e., to utilize this checklist to	
	assess OCAB first, make recommendations to the County Council if	
	needed, and share it with Oxford County's businesses/organizations.	
	Oxford County adopted the City of London's Facility Accessibility Design	
	Standard(FADS) in 2004. A basic checklist was developed to guide the	
	County's businesses/organizations and the County itself with the intent of	
	not policing but identifying accessibility issues. Gord mentioned that the	
	City of London's Facility Accessibility Design Standard(FADS) has an	
	updated version from 2021.	
	AAC reviewed the existing County Accessibility Assessment Form while	
	referring to the OBIAA Accessibility Checklist document, which is more	
	elaborate and includes more categories, e.g., Building Interior and	
	Signage, and has suggestions for overcoming inaccessibility. Ayesha	
	identified the questions already covered in Oxford County's Accessibility	
	Assessment Form, similar to the OBIAA Accessibility Checklist	
	questions. So, AAC worked on including important and inclusive	
	questions and advised adding suggestions to Oxford County's Accessibility	
	Assessment Form. While reviewing the OBIAA Checklist document, AAC	
	realized that many questions stated in this document are repetitive and can	
	also be included as suggestions for the County's Assessment Form. The	
	AAC advised removing categories of life safety and additional information	
	from the County's document.	
	It was noted that having a final version of Oxford County's Accessibility	
	Assessment Form before the Joint Accessibility Committee meeting would	
	be a good document to share with the other Municipalities' Staff Leads.

Joint Accessibility Committee Meeting	Ayesha informed the Committee that the sub-committee member Pauline had contacted Oxford County's residents to share their stories of lived experiences regarding accessibility achievements or barriers that could be a learning experience for Area Municipalities Staff Leads.
